*Young Woman: "One night as I lay in bed, I yearned deeply for my lover, but he did not come.*

*Song 4:1-4*

*Young Man: "How beautiful you are, my beloved, how beautiful! Your eyes behind your veil are like doves. Your hair falls in waves, like a flock of goats frisking down the slopes of Gilead. [2] Your teeth are as white as sheep, newly shorn and washed. They are perfectly matched; not one is missing. [3] Your lips are like a ribbon of scarlet. Oh, how beautiful your mouth! Your cheeks behind your veil are like pomegranate halves—lovely and delicious. [4] Your neck is as stately as the tower of David, jeweled with the shields of a thousand heroes.*
